

STEP 1: CONNECT YOUR THERMOSTAT TO YOUR NETWORK

Make sure your network can connect to the Internet. Open a browser on your PC, Mac or tablet and go to any website, such as networkthermostat.com to verify you're connected.

Wi-Fi Thermostat Versions:

Your NetX[™] thermostat should already be connected to your network using Soft AP configuration. For more information on the Soft AP Configuration see 240094_DirectConnect_RP32-UP32-WIFI Quick Start Guide.

Ethernet Thermostat Versions:

Your NetX[™] thermostat should already be connected to your network simply by plugging a patch cable between the thermostat dongle and your network router or switch.

STEP 2: ENROLL YOUR THERMOSTAT

You can quickly enroll your thermostat via the netx-cloud.com site. This requires an Internet connection for the thermostat. (If you're installing the thermostat on a stand-alone private network with no Internet connection, refer to the detailed instructions 240094-NetX-WIFI-DirectConnect-Quick-Start-Guide or 240175-DirectConnect-NetX-IP-Quick-Start-Guide.)

1) Go to <u>https://netx-cloud.com/enroll.php</u> and enter the following

STEP 3: CONNECT TO YOUR THERMOSTAT USING NetX[™] CloudConnect[™] SERVICE

Now that you're all set up, you can use any current release browser (Firefox, Internet Explorer, Chrome, or Safari) to log into your thermostat(s) using the CloudConnect[™] service.

Simply go to <u>networkthermostat.com</u> and click **CloudConnect™ Login** in the upper right hand corner (or, go to <u>https://netx-cloud.com</u>). When you log in with your user name (email) and password, you will see your list of your thermostats, but the 'location' will be blank.

To update the location to the 'Site Name' you entered earlier, simply expand each thermostat (click the '+' to the left of the thermostat name), then navigate to the Basic Configuration page under the thermostat. NetX[™] CloudConnect[™] will then record the site name. Follow this same process for each of your thermostats, and then log out and log in again. When you log in again, the Site Name will be seen for the location. If you'd like to separate your thermostats into different locations (groupings can be of anything that makes sense to you), just update the Site Name on the Basic Configuration page, log out and log back in.

Every thermostat is automatically enrolled for Full CloudConnect[™] experience for 30 days starting the day the thermostat is registered. If you'd like to continue the subscription to the service after the 30 days, purchase a subscription at <u>www.networkhvac.com</u>. There are several different subscription options to choose from.

If you decide you don't want or need the CloudConnect[™] service, refer to the DirectConnect[™] instructions and move your thermostat to a static IP address and port forward your router, as described in the DirectConnect[™] documentation.
